Following the Estyn inspection in June 2022 the school worked on the following four recommendations. Following evaluation and Progress review the progress against each recommendation was judged as follows:

Recommendation	Progress Judgement
Priority 1: Ensure leaders focus better on addressing the variability in the quality of teaching.	Very Good progress has been made in this area.
Priority 2: Ensure that all teachers have high expectations in order to challenge pupils more effectively.	Very Good progress has been made in this area.
Priority 3: Improve pupils' independent skills	Strong progress has been made in this area.
Priority 4: Provide more meaningful opportunities for pupils to influence the wider life of the school.	Very Good progress has been made in this area.

Priorities
1. To embed a curriculum that is progressive and meets the needs of and engages all pupils.
2. To continue to develop both formative and summative assessment approaches that allow the accurate tracking of pupil progress over time
3. To embed constantly good learning and teaching throughout school.
4. To embed consistently high leadership (including governors) across all levels of the school.
