

Our Pupil Profile: St Francis Values and Virtues:

The Jesuit Pupil Profile proposes eight pairs of virtues that sum up what a pupil in a Jesuit school is growing to be.

In St Francis RC Primary we describe what a child in our care is growing to be and how the school is consciously and deliberately nurturing this.

Alongside the pupil profile itself, we have developed a parallel statement of what a Jesuit school does to help its pupils grow in the virtues listed in the JPP.

Our aims in creating our Jesuit Pupil Profile (JPP) have been:

-to propose a simple but challenging statement of the qualities we seek to develop in pupils in Jesuit schools, using key words which unfold Ignatius' own stated aim of "improvement in living and learning for the greater glory of God and the common good."

Attentive and discerning
Compassionate and loving
Faith-filled and hopeful
Eloquent and truthful
Learned and wise
Curious and active
Intentional and prophetic

Each half term we focus on a pair of these virtues to enhance our good qualities through our catholic faith.

Grateful for their own gifts, for the gift of other people, and for the blessings of each day; and **generous** with their gifts, now and in the future.

Attentive to their experience and to their vocation; and **discerning** about the choices they make and the effects of those choices.

Compassionate towards others, near and far, especially the less fortunate; and **loving** by their just actions and forgiving words.

Faith-filled in their beliefs and **hopeful** for the future.

Eloquent and **truthful** in what they say of themselves, the relations between people, and the world.

Learned, finding God in all things; and **wise** in the ways they use their learning for the common good.

Curious about everything; and **active** in their engagement with the world, changing what they can for the better

Intentional in the way they live and use the resources of the earth, guided by conscience and **prophetic** in the example they set to others.
